

Wordly Wise Completion Instructions

1. **The Words:** Review all fifteen words. Read carefully, making note of the *part of speech*, and multiple definitions.
2. **Section A - Finding Meanings**
 - Circle the two phrases
 - Write a complete sentence using the two phrases.
3. **Section B. Just the Right Word**
 - Use the *correct form* of the word.
 - Read the revised sentence aloud to ensure that you have the correct form of the word. If it doesn't sound right, it probably isn't correct.
4. **Section C - Applying Meanings**
 - Read all choices carefully. You must get all of them correct to get full credit. If you miss one, it's half off, more than one and you miss the entire question.
5. **Section D - Word Study: Synonyms, Antonyms, Homophones, Completing Sentences**
 - The directions in Section D vary, so read *carefully*. You do not have to copy the sentence starters in the "completing sentences" exercises. Just finish the sentence and add a period at the end.
6. **Section E - Vocabulary in Context**

Read the entire passage closely and carefully. Then use vocabulary words to answer the questions. Remember, each vocabulary word is only used once.

 - Answer each question in a *complete sentence* using the vocabulary word.
 - **Put a box around the vocabulary word.**
 - Make sure to use the correct form of the word.
 - If the word is already given in the question, write your complete sentence using that word. Example: "What is the meaning of **character** as it is used in the passage?" Character means "the qualities that make a person or place different or special."
 - For definitions, use the definition given with the word list.
